



RSU Scholarship Auditions Set for April 14th

Music Directors,

I am pleased to announce that the music program at Rogers State University will hold auditions for scholarships for the upcoming 2012-2013 school year on Saturday, April 14, 2012. Auditions will be held in the Baird Hall Performance Studio on the campus of Rogers State University – Claremore Campus at 10 a.m. and will be arranged on a first-come, first-served basis.

Please post the enclosed information flyer for any students who might be interested in auditioning. An accompanist will be on campus if needed; however, students are free to bring their own accompanist if they wish. Sight-reading will be included in both instrumental and vocal auditions.

Scholarships range from \$400-\$1200 per year in the form of a tuition waiver. Students who are awarded scholarships are asked to participate in one of RSU's music ensembles that best fit their interest for the entire academic year as part of their obligation to the university. I am also pleased to be able to announce the formation of a new Performance Grant scholarship to begin in the 2011-12 school year. These grants are NOT tuition waivers and may be added to any scholarship offered at RSU. The awards are further explained in the **Guidelines for Music Scholarships** available on the Music Program website.

The Rogers State University Music Program currently consists of three performing ensembles, Jazz Ensemble, Pep Band, and Choir. A fourth ensemble, the RSU Concert Band, is currently awaiting board approval for the 2012-13 school year. RSU also currently offers 13 credited courses in music including a minor in music.
