SENIORS

ACT Requirements

- Minimum 19 Composite
- Minimum 19 sub score in desired subject area

JUNIORS

ACT Requirements

- Minimum 21 Composite
- Minimum 19 sub score in desired subject area

ALL CONCURRENT STUDENTS

Please Note

- Concurrent students may enroll in a combined number of high school and college courses per semester not to exceed 19 credit hours. For purposes of calculating workload, one-half high school unit shall be equivalent to three semester credit hours.
- Concurrent students may enroll in up to 9 hours during a summer semester without being enrolled in high school summer classes.
- In order to continue concurrent enrollment, students must maintain a minimum 2.0 college GPA.
