To Whom It May Concern,

I am writing on behalf of the Transnational Association of Christian Colleges and Schools (TRACS) to clarify the accreditation status of the Teach-Out Plan for American Christian College and Seminary. In short, students who had completed 75% of their degree program prior to June of 2004 were allowed to earn an accredited degree, provided that the course work was completed by the end of May 2005.

American Christian College and Seminary (ACCS) was accredited February 28, 1996 through May 31, 2005. ACCS was then closed and no degrees were awarded for students who had requirements lacking after May 31, 2005.
